- Your cooler, pic-nic style for lunches or more, water bottle...
- Clothing for all temperature, including a wind breaker.
 ***In case of rain, a covered shelter will be available.
- Also: A wide brim hat that can be attached, or an umbrella of some sort...

Outdoor spinning recommandations:

Wind is *NOT* a negligeable factor by the sea;

Plan to bring a bag or basket that closes well, material/fibre prepared in a concise way so as not to catch in the wind and ideally READY to use (rolags, cotton roving, wool staples to spin on the fold...).
